
In November of 2021 I proudly completed a 6 month full stack bootcamp program through PDX Code Guild and I've continued to practice and work on fun projects.

In my coding bootcamp, I designed and built an app I'm super proud of.




Cycle. App is an inclusive, predictive, and customizable menstrual cycle tracking app for all menstruating people.


It was created for people in gender non-conforming bodies to track their cycles in order to get pregnant, avoid pregnancy, or gain awareness around their individual cycle patterns.

Users can see all events on a calendar, log events, and view their cycle stats at a glance.








My process:

My first wireframe sketch.




- Interviewed potential users
